LACC 201: Writing Assignment 5

For this fifth and final assignment, worth 25% of your final grade, consider something that you believe needs to change in your work or home environment, and write a clear, effective paragraph asking for that change. The change should involve other people, demanding more than just a new choice on your part. What is the issue? Who is involved? Why should things change? Be sure to consider your purpose and your audience: Why are you writing this? To whom? What will they learn from it? Is it possible you could use what you write to request the needed change?

In completing this assignment, you need to:

- (1) Focus on a problem that demands change. Decide what argument you will make, and carefully consider the purpose and audience of your paper.
- (2) Gather at least two written and/or electronic sources.
- (3) Write a university-level paragraph in which you clearly and convincingly argue your claim, adhering to the elements of an effective paragraph and using your two sources effectively and ethically.

All papers for this course must adhere to APA formatting; for specifics, reference the APA Sample Essay, APA Template, and APA links at the top of our course site. See the Syllabus for details about Late Papers, Revisions, and Turnitin.

Please consider the following:

Purpose: To persuade your audience to think differently about a topic of your choosing.

Audience: Your choice, although must be more than one person and appropriate to your purpose. Be sure to attach a one-paragraph audience description to your draft, using proper APA format for an Appendix (see Audience Description handout).

Due Date: By midnight on Sunday. Final papers must be in APA format, edited carefully, and below a 10% Turnitin score.
