

Writing Assignment 1

For this first assignment, read pages 480-481. Then, write **one paragraph** based on one of Arlov's four "Topics for Writing" assignments on pp. 484. As you consider your topic, remember that any writing must have a purpose and an audience. What specific life examples can you give, either from your own life or from the lives of others, that demonstrate your ideas? What advice can you offer others based on the walk you have led thus far? What regrets do you have about your own path, and what hopes do you have for the future? What life lessons can you teach?

Remember, too, that an effective paragraph must have a clear topic sentence followed by evidence (see Ch. 3-4 in Arlov and/or sections W-2a and W-4 in Bullock).

Purpose: To explore your attitudes toward boundary-setting. What greater life lesson might readers glean from your essay?
